Super-zesty in acidity, this unoaked Sauvignon Blanc also is dry and rich. It swamps the palate with lemon, lime, grapefruit, fig and green grass flavors that finish long and spicy. —S.H.

2009 Mutt Lynch Winery Fou Fou le Blanc Central Coast Sauvignon Blanc (\$14).

The Lynch family named its winery Mutt Lynch, uses labels that bear a cartoon dog, and offer “yappy hour” in their dog-friendly tasting room. This bottling offers lemon custard, ripe pear and citrus with slightly pithy lemon peel on the finish. It gets somewhat candied as it warms, so drink cold with simple fish dishes.
