This noble beast opens to aromas of toasty oak and blackberries. On the palate you'll find notes of blackberries, cherries, tobacco and leather. The 2013 HellHound is full-bodied, with silky tannins and a nice finish. Available now for a great taste but will also age well. We're at the mercy of this beauty of a beast. It's big, bold and very tempting.
