Perotti Vineyard, Dry Creek Valley

I first met Ed and Bruce Perotti, father and son grape growers in Dry Creek Valley, in 1997. I immediately fell in love with their Zinfandel vineyard and have been producing small amounts of wine from their grapes ever since. Located on the north end of Dry Creek Valley, on a bench with an eastern slope, this location ensures great air circulation and exposure, dry skins and ripe fruit. As they say in real estate and winemaking—location, location, location!

Brenda's Winemaking

Handle with care. Pre-fermentation, the grapes were cold-soaked to extract both color and flavor. Press-off and 100% in-barrel fermentation followed to develop mid-palate weight and texture. My 2014 vintage was aged in 100% French Oak barrels for 18 months.

Tasting Notes

Our 2014 mbf Zinfandel has a lovely nuanced and textured elegance. With aromas of licorice and black pepper and a flavor profile that's dominated by plum and raspberry, the wine speaks to balance. It has medium acidity and moderate tannins and a wonderful smooth mouthfeel. One taste will evoke the sun setting on the benchland soils from which this beautiful fruit was grown. Life is good...
